SIT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCESS

MID JANUARY

Apply for Admissions via the SIT online application portal at SingaporeTech.edu.sg.

Apply for the SIT Scholarship through the Financial Aid application.

You should be applying for the SIT Scholarship in the same year you are seeking to matriculate.

SIT Application Portal: Select your submitted Admissions application to access the Financial Aid application.



FEBRUARY TO MAY

Shortlisted applicants for Admissions will be assessed through interviews, written tests and submission of portfolio.



APRIL TO MAY

Check your Admissions application outcome via email notification from SIT or via the SIT online application portal.

Successful applicants for Admissions are required to accept your offer by the Joint Acceptance deadline.

Shortlisted candidates for SIT Scholarship will be invited for an interview assessment.



JUNE

Check your SIT Scholarship application outcome via email notification from SIT or via the SIT online application portal.

Successful applicants for the SIT Scholarship are required to accept the offer by the stipulated deadline in your e-offer letter.

At SIT, we recognise and nurture our students through the wide array of scholarships made available by SIT and its extensive partnerships. At the same time, SIT is committed to provide students access to an excellent education without letting any financial challenges get in the way. Through the Financial Assistance schemes available, we aim to empower you to take charge of your education journey.

MOE TUITION GRANT (TG) SCHEME

As a full-time undergraduate student, you may apply for TG to assist with the costs of your education. The TG is available to Singapore Citizens (SC), Singapore Permanent Residents (SPR) and most International Students (IS).

SIT students who are awarded the grant will pay subsidised tuition fees.

Students who have received TG for studies in degree programmes at NUS, NTU, SMU, SUTD, SIT, LASALLE or NAFA will be eligible for TG up to the total credits required for graduation at SIT less the percentage of semesters or trimesters of TG received at your previous university.

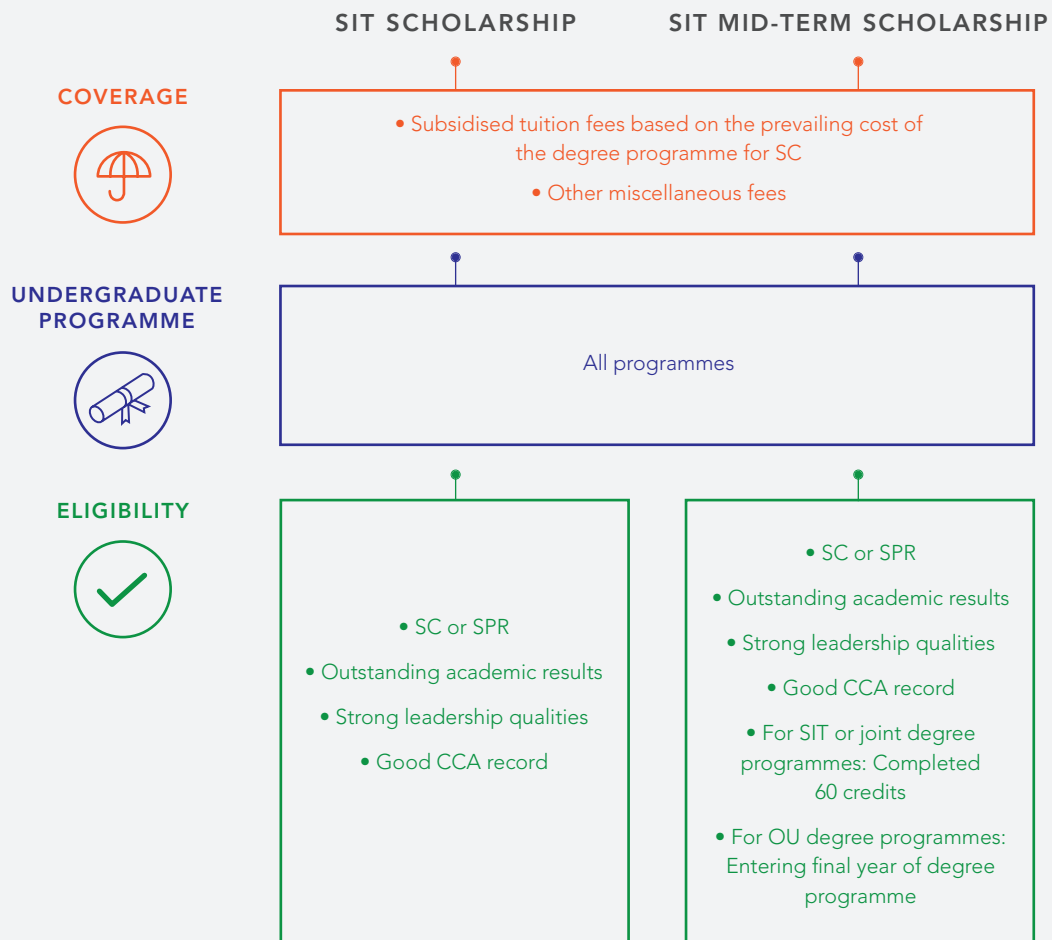
If you have fully utilised your TG for degree programmes and were conferred degree qualifications, you will have to pay non-subsidised fees for the entire duration of your new programme at SIT.

TG subsidies are not repayable but SPR and IS are required to sign a TG agreement and work in a Singaporean entity for three years upon graduation from SIT. There are no service obligations for SC.

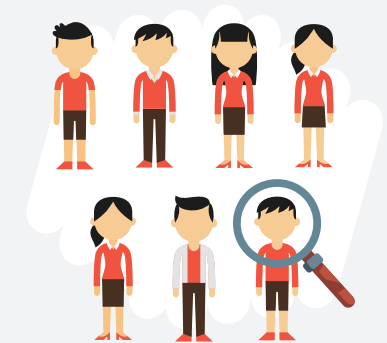

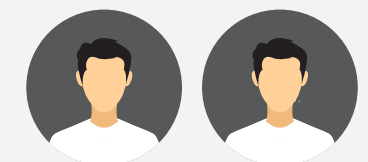

TUITION FEE LOAN (TFL)

SC/SPR/IS¹

Up to 90% of subsidised tuition fees payable by SC.

- Between 21 to 60 years of age.
- Must not be an undischarged bankrupt.
- No income qualification required.
- Must not have guaranteed more than 2 student loans.
 - Nationality:
 - SC guarantor for SC applicant;
 - SC/SPR guarantor for SPR applicant;
 - SC/SPR/Foreigner for IS applicant.

Apply online via IN4SIT* and generate the Application Form to submit to a DBS branch by the stipulated deadline.

SIT STUDY LOAN (SIT SL)

- SC/SPR with a PCI of no more than \$2,700.
- IS¹ with a PCI of no more than \$1,200.

- Up to 10% of subsidised tuition fees payable by SC².
- Living Allowance option of S\$3,600 per annum.

- Apply online via IN4SIT* with uploaded supporting documents for income eligibility assessment by the stipulated deadline.
- Upon approval, student is to present the Letter of Approval and Loan Agreement Form at a DBS branch.

1. IS must be in receipt of the MOE TG in order to apply for the TFL and SIT SL.
2. For use of SIT SL for payment of tuition fees, applicants must have also applied for the TFL.
3. Approved loan quantum does not include miscellaneous fees.
4. Total combined loan quantum from TFL, SIT SL and/or CPFES cannot exceed 100% of the subsidised tuition fees payable.
5. Students will only need to apply for this loan once for the duration of the degree programme at SIT.

SC/PR/IS who are in receipt of the MOE TG.

- Up to 100% of subsidised tuition fees payable by undergraduate students.
- CPF member may only use up to 40% of accumulated savings in the ordinary account, excluding amounts withdrawn for housing.

- SC/SPR: No guarantor requirement. However, the CPF Board reserves the right to require a student to furnish a guarantor acceptable to the Board when it is deemed necessary.
- IS have to furnish details of a guarantor upon application.

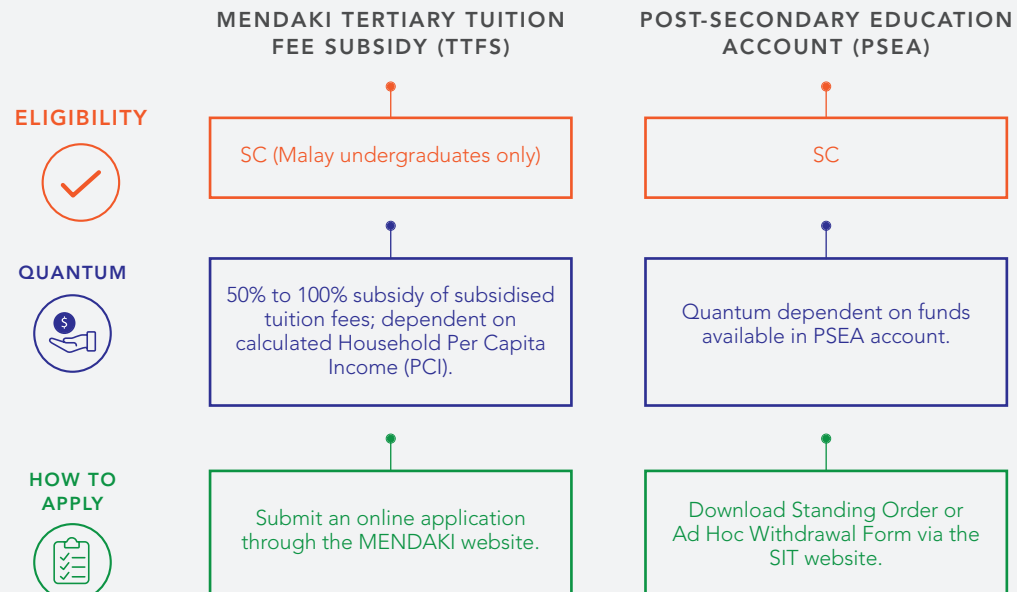
- SC/SPR: Login using SingPass via CPF Board website.
- IS: Hardcopy application to be submitted to SIT.

1. IS must be in receipt of the MOE TG in order to apply for the TFL and SIT SL.
2. For use of SIT SL for payment of tuition fees, applicants must have also applied for the TFL.
3. Approved loan quantum does not include miscellaneous fees.
4. Total combined loan quantum from TFL, SIT SL and/or CPFES cannot exceed 100% of the subsidised tuition fees payable.
5. Students will only need to apply for this loan once for the duration of the degree programme at SIT.

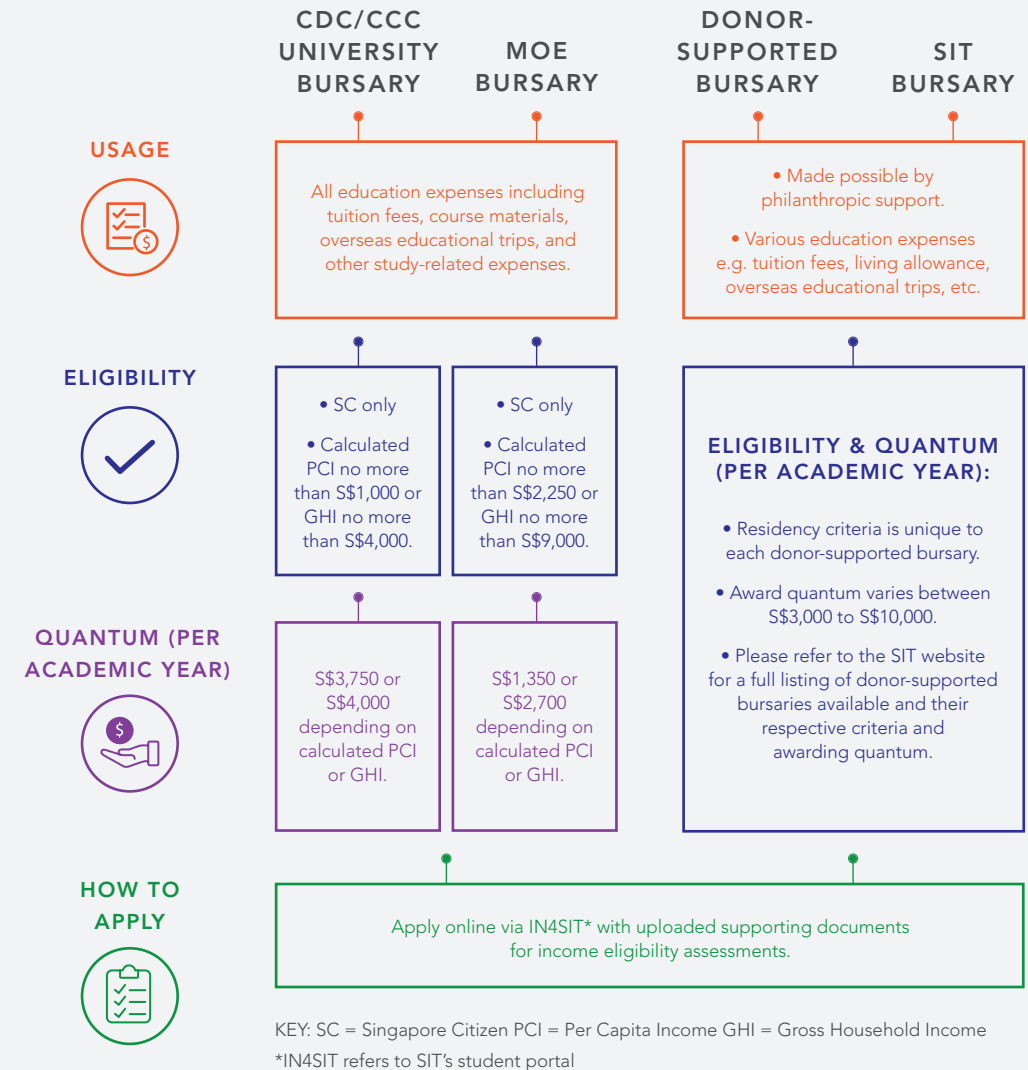
OVERSEAS STUDENT PROGRAMME (OSP) LOAN

SC or SPR students who require financial assistance for their Overseas Immersion Programme (OIP) or Overseas Exposure Programme (OEP) may apply for the OSP Loan. Loan requirements are similar to loans meant for the payment of tuition fees. Students will be briefed in greater detail closer to the months before departure.

STUDENT LAPTOP SUPPORT SCHEME

Students who are unable to afford a laptop for educational purposes may approach the Student Life Division to enquire on a laptop unit loan; loans will be approved subject to fulfilment of eligibility criteria.

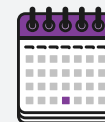
