SIT looks beyond grades and views each applicant as an individual with diverse qualities and talents. All shortlisted applicants will be assessed through interviews to ascertain if they are well-suited for the programme of choice. A prospective applicant with a certain Grade Point Average (GPA)/University Admission Score (UAS) can make broad reference to the "success rate" for applicants in the respective banding for a specific programme in the last admissions exercise, to assess his/her chances of being admitted.

Applicants may also refer to the latest Graduate Employment Survey results (employment rate and median salary) of the respective programmes, where available.
