This annual event brings together regulators, industry leaders, engineering professionals and researchers to exchange knowledge and explore applied innovations shaping a more sustainable, resilient and high-performance built environment. Complementing the presentations is an industry exhibition showcasing research outcomes, emerging technologies and practical solutions developed across the Consortium's research work packages. Participants will have opportunities to engage with project teams and learn how collaborative research is being translated into scalable, real-world applications.

The event will also mark the launch of Woh Hup–SIT–A*STAR Consortium Research Programme for Sustainable Construction Technology, the official opening of the CTIL laboratory space, and the pre-launch of the new CRC Press book - Design of Headed Anchorage Bars in Reinforced Concrete Structures.

Through technical sharing, exhibitions, discussions and networking, the seminar aims to strengthen collaboration among industry, academia and public agencies while accelerating the adoption of sustainable and resilient construction solutions.
