



UNDERGRADUATE APPLICATION GUIDE FOR APPLICANTS PRESENTING INTERNATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants presenting an international qualification from an overseas educational institute, who have completed at least 12 years of formal education may apply for admission.

Applying to SIT

SIT has only one intake per year. SIT's annual admissions period is held from January to March each year. Applicants are required to present actual results by application closing in March.

Exceptions:

- (i) If you are sitting for the May IB exam, you may submit your application with forecasted results before application closing date on 19 March, and provide the actual IB results to SIT upon release in early July. Refer to this link for further details;
- (ii) If you are a graduating applicant and your final Year 12 results are not yet available by the application deadline (but will be released before early July), you may still apply during this year's application window. In this case, you should submit your Year 12 Semester 1 results along with your Year 10 and Year 11 school results as part of your application.

Applicants presenting international qualifications should submit the following when applying to SIT.

- 'A' Level/ Year 12 examination results (Entry Qualification)
- 'O' Level/ Year 10 examination results
- High school transcript with explanation of grading system
- For applicants whose language of instruction in high school is not English, an acceptable English language test score (e.g. IELTS, TOEFL) should be submitted. Refer to Table 2.
- Additional test results where required (e.g. SAT, SAT Subject tests). Refer to Table 1 and Table
- Documents that are not in English should be accompanied by a certified English translation.

In the online application form, you will be required to select your Entry Qualification, which is usually your 'A' Level/ High School Year 12 qualification if you have obtained your qualification overseas. You may provide information on additional qualifications/ test results (e.g. Degree, TOEFL/IELTS, SAT, SAT Subject Test or other certificates) under the Supplementary Qualification section.

Applications are assessed holistically taking into consideration academic results (e.g. A Level, High School Certificate), additional qualifications or test results submitted (e.g. SAT, SAT Subject Tests, Advanced Placement, IELTS, TOEFL), relevant work experience/internship/competitions/awards, and personal statement. Admission is competitive, and shortlisted applicants will be required to attend an admission interview.

There are programme-specific English language requirements for some programmes, and applicants are required to fulfil whichever is the higher requirement. For programme-specific requirements, please refer to the <u>respective programme web pages</u>.

Applicants who do not meet the English Language Requirements may be invited to complete an English Test conducted by SIT.

SAT Subject Tests

Applicants are required to submit three <u>SAT Subject Test scores</u>, including Math Level 2. The other two subjects should be chosen with respect to relevancy to the programme(s) applied for.

Alternatively, applicants may submit <u>Advanced Placement (AP)</u> scores in three subjects, including Calculus. The other two AP subjects should be relevant to the programme(s) applied for.
