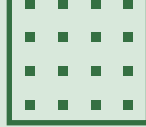

Once again, we warmly welcome you to SIT and wish you every success in your SITizen journey!

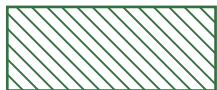

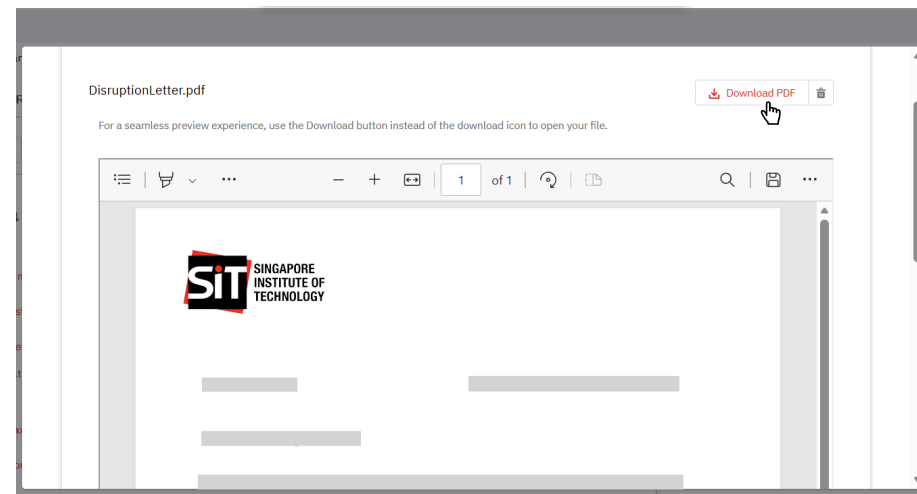

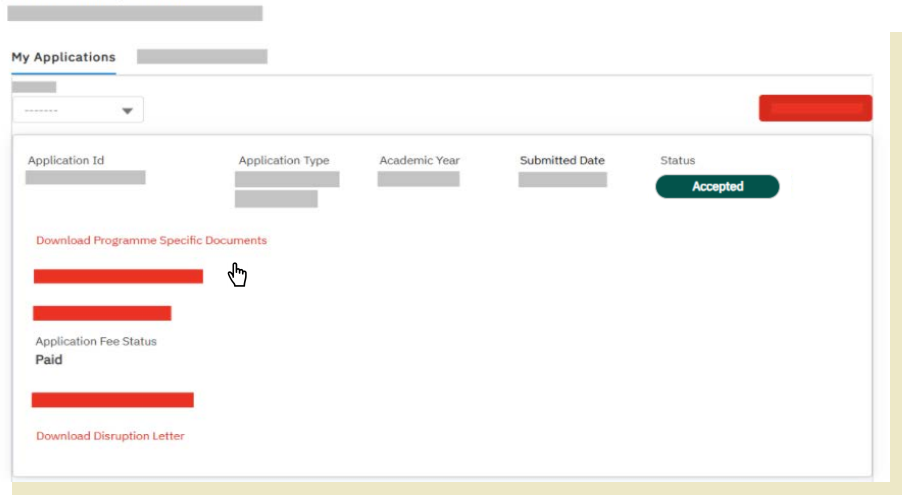
Upon login, please click on the "Download Disruption Letter" link at the bottom left.

A pop-up window will appear displaying your disruption letter. This letter will indicate your programme of study. Click on the "Download PDF" button to download the letter.



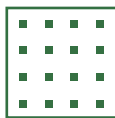


Next, download Annex A.
