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FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear Esteemed Partners and Friends,

Ten years ago, SIT began a bold journey to redefine higher education in Singapore. As the nation's first University of Applied Learning, we set out to bridge the gap between academia and industry. Our focus has always been to develop work-ready graduates who contribute meaningfully to Singapore's economy and society.

We have made significant progress since. The percentage of our graduates who are employed within six months of graduation is on par with the more established Autonomous Universities in Singapore. An overwhelming majority – over 90% – of our students are reading their first-choice degree programmes, and very few “leak” to other sectors of work upon graduation. Close to half of our students receive advanced employment offers from their Integrated Work Study Programme (internship) employers before completing their studies, and a handful of companies even recognise this internship period as

the first year of employment when the students accept their offers.

An SIT education today goes beyond the mere acquisition of disciplinary knowledge – it fosters the mastery of competencies to apply this knowledge effectively. Our programmes also help students build critical transferable skills such as critical thinking, effective communication and the ability to work in multi-disciplinary teams that will enable them to thrive and lead in a fast-changing world.

The opening of Punggol Campus in the Punggol Digital District marks a significant milestone in our journey. More than a physical space, the campus is a high-tech, high touch living lab where innovation and collaboration converge. Here, our students, academic staff and industry partners can co-create solutions to uplift society through applied learning and translational research. This new chapter brings exciting

opportunities to deepen and broaden our reach.

This progress has been made possible through the steadfast support of our donors and the wider community. Your belief in our mission enables us to nurture future-ready graduates, empower transformative learning experiences, and translate innovation into real-world impact.

Looking ahead, our aspirations while bold are clear. Over the next decade, we will continue to expand flexible, competency-based, lifelong pathways for upskilling and reskilling. As Singapore's University for Industry, we will deepen our partnerships with industry and drive impactful solutions that help companies scale up and strengthen Singapore's innovation ecosystem.

Thank you for believing in our mission. Your continued support empowers tomorrow's changemakers.

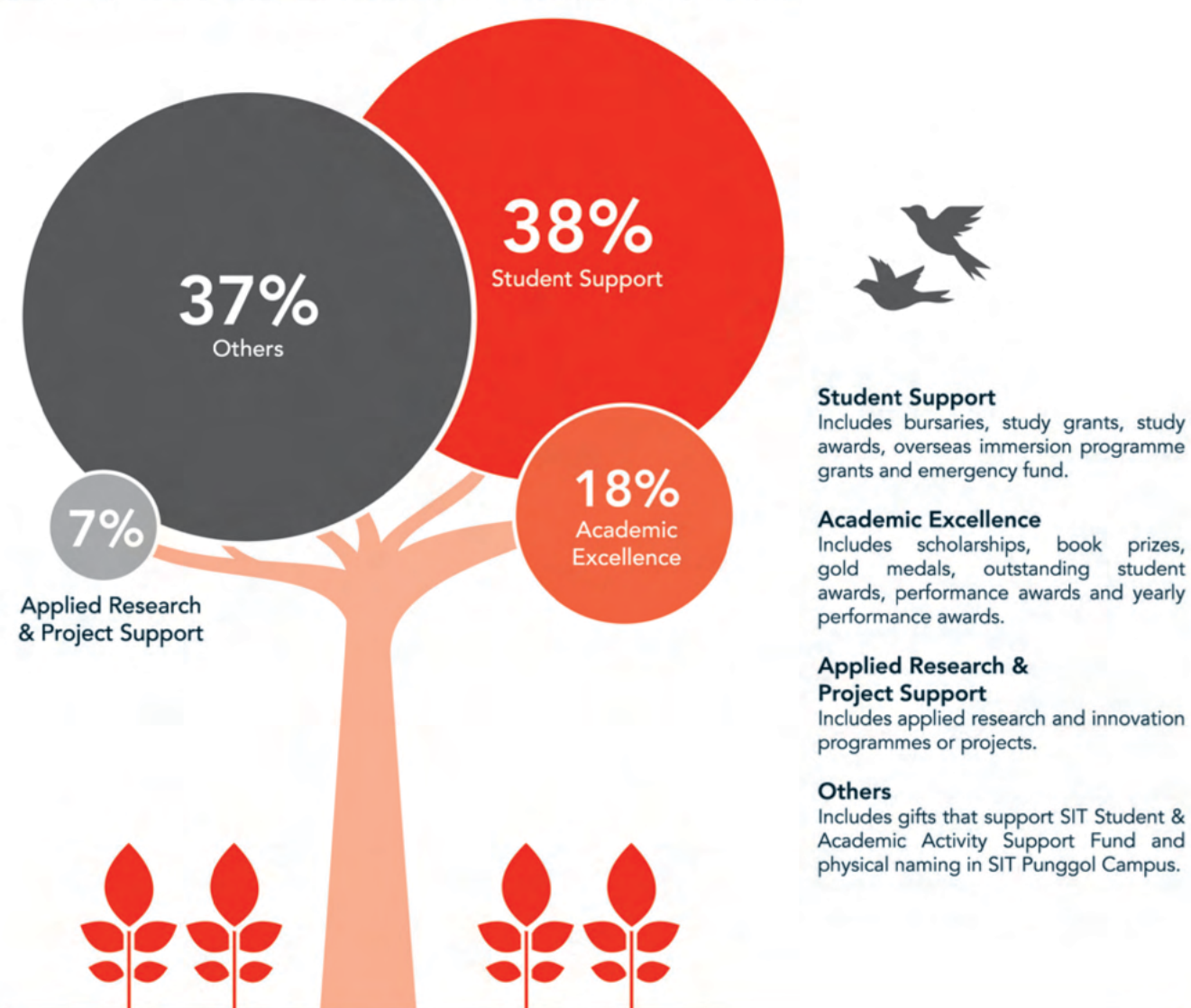

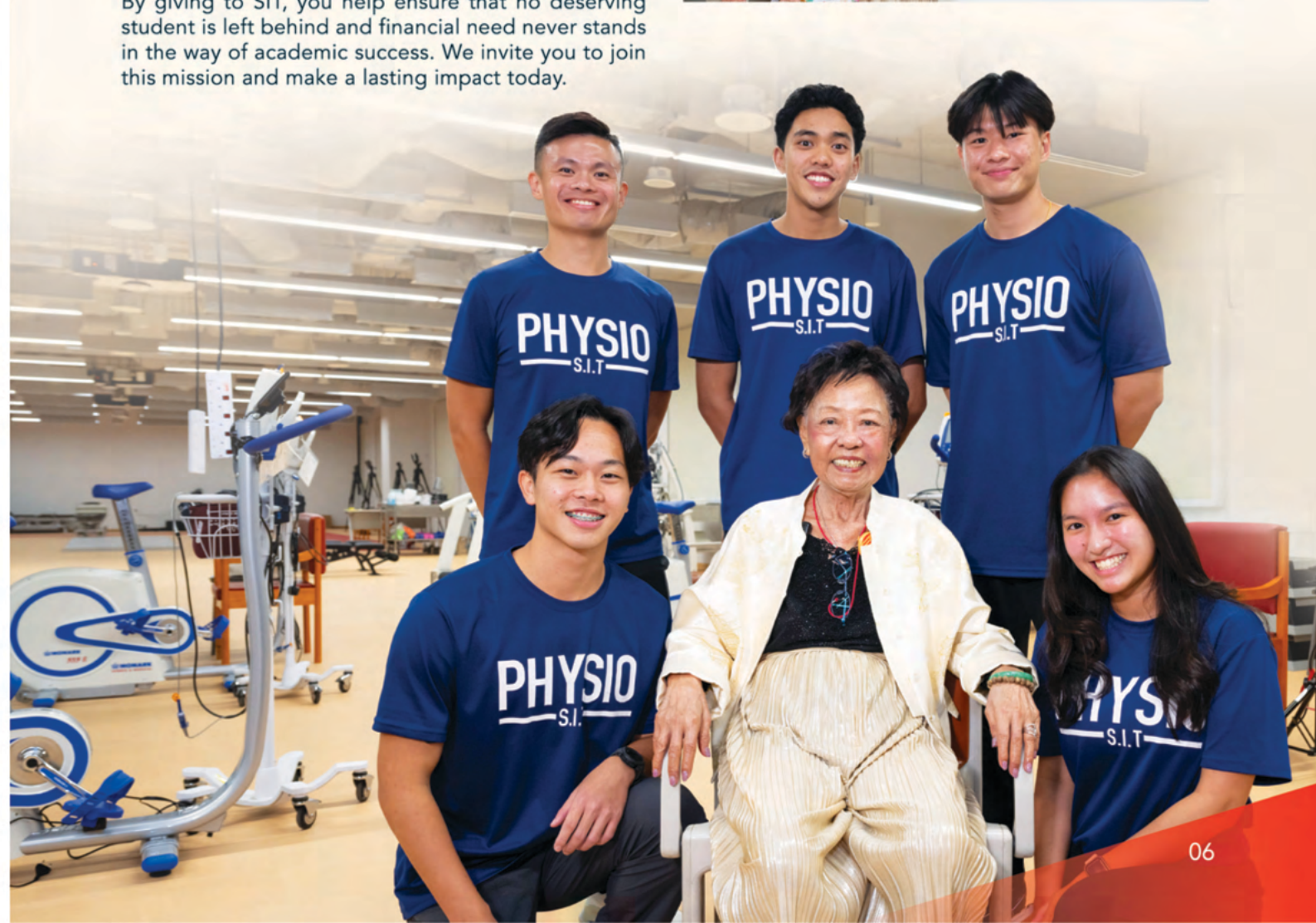
