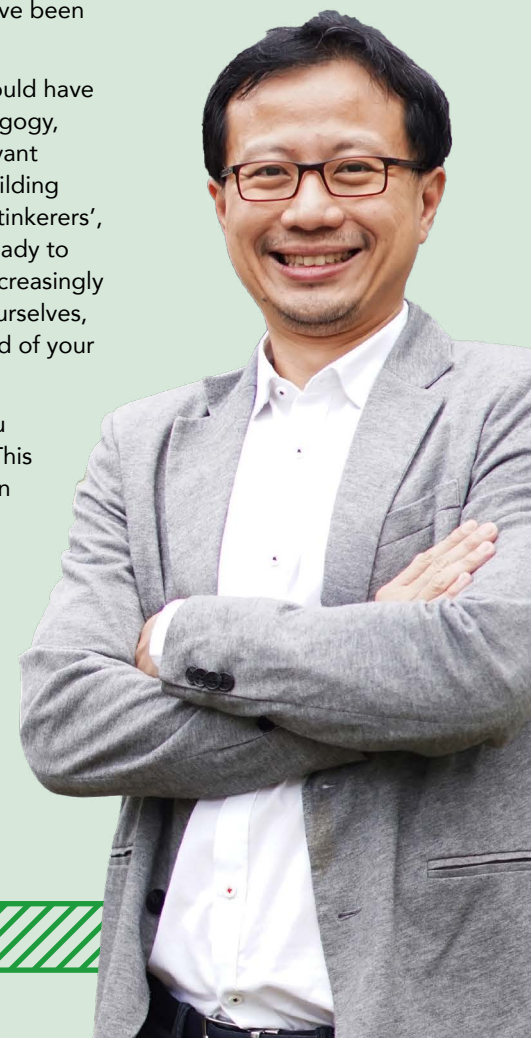

Register A New Account

1. Please sign in to submit a new application. First-time applicants may proceed to register a new account.

2. Your User ID refers to the 9 numeric digits sent to your email address when you first register your account.

3. You may also login using your email address previously registered with SIT.

4. Your password is in the format of 8-16 characters and is case sensitive.

5. Your personal identification (full NRIC for SC/SPR, FIN and/or Passport for International students) is collected for the purpose of establishing your identity, and to facilitate the processing of your application for admissions.

6. Please refer to the step-by-step Undergraduate Application Guide to complete your online application.

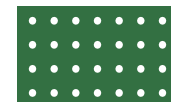

Please DO NOT select the 2nd option.

If you are selecting the 2nd option, it means that you are declining the placement that SIT has reserved for you.

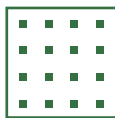

MATRICULATION

All successful applicants who have accepted SIT's offers are required to complete the matriculation process before commencing their studies in SIT. To complete the pre-matriculation exercise please refer to the MATRICULATION GUIDE, which will be sent to you by June 2022.



Important Dates and Deadlines

For the AY2022/2023 intake, the pre-matriculation package will be sent to students via e-mail as per the schedule below:

- Food Business Management – 15 May 2022 onwards
- Allied Health Programmes – 15 May 2022 onwards
- All other programmes – from 1 June 2022 onwards.
