

POSTGRADUATE APPLICATION GUIDE FOR APPLICANTS PRESENTING INTERNATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants presenting an international qualification where the language of instruction is not English are required to submit an acceptable English language test score (refer to Table A). The test must have been taken within two years prior to the date of application to be considered valid.

Table A:

IELTS (Academic)	6.5
TOEFL (Internet-based Test)	90
Cambridge 'O' Level English/ EL1119	C6
Cambridge English C1 Advanced or C2 Proficiency	C1 Advanced or C2 Proficiency

Applying to SIT

The application period for the different postgraduate programme differs, please refer to www.singaporetech.edu.sg/admissions/postgraduate for the latest application timeline. Interested applicants may submit an online application via [Postgraduate Application System](#) and the following required documents:

- Bachelor's degree certificate and transcript (Entry Qualification)
- For applicants whose language of instruction in university is not English, an acceptable English language test score (e.g. IELTS, TOEFL) should be submitted. Refer to Table A.
- Documents that are not in English should be accompanied by a certified English translation

In the online application form, you will be required to select your Entry Qualification, which is your bachelor's degree. You may provide information on additional qualifications/test results (e.g. TOEFL/IELTS or other certificates) under the Supplementary Qualification section.
