



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

1. Who are the organisers of this competition?

- This competition is jointly organised by the Singapore Institute of Technology (SIT) and JTC Corporation (JTC).

2. What are the categories of this competition?

- There are two (2) categories for this competition, namely:
 - a) Open Category (Managed by JTC)
 - b) School Categories (Managed by SIT)
- Under the School Categories, there are 2 sub-categories namely:
 - a) Primary Schools
 - b) Secondary Schools

3. What are the corresponding Themes of each category?

- Open Category, “The Future of Work, Live & Play”
- School Categories, “The Future of Education”

4. Is it possible for enter both the Open and School Categories?

- Yes, as long as the entries submitted abides to the theme and conditions of eligibility for each category.

5. How will the People’s Choice winner be selected?

- The winner will be selected based on the number of likes accumulated on SIT’s and JTC’s Facebook post during the judging period.

6. How will the three (3) voters for People’s Choice be selected?

- For each Competition Category, three (3) Voters will be selected randomly from all the Voters who posted to support the winner of the “People’s Choice” on SIT’s and JTC’s official Facebook page [www.facebook.com/SingaporeTech and www.facebook.com/JTC] during the Voting Period.

7. What should I include in the description for my entry?

- A short write-up is a good way to provide context and to guide the judges to see the illustration/photograph in a particular way, and to increase engagement with your audience.



8. How many times can I submit an entry per category?

- You can submit a maximum of 20 entries per category; however, the entries cannot be repeated nor have been entered in previous competitions.

9. I would like to submit an entry that has previously won a contest. Is that allowed?

- This is not allowed. We do not accept entries that have won other competitions before.

10. Why is it that I cannot upload my file?

- Do make sure your file meets the following requirements:
 - a) JPEG, TIFF, PNG file format
 - b) Total file size per attachment must be no larger than
 - i) 3 megabytes (MB) in size, for the Open Category (if the file size is between 3MB to 30MB, please send the photograph via email – refer to instructions stated in the online submission form)
 - ii) 30 megabytes (MB) in size, for the School Categories

11. Can I submit a hard copy entry?

- We will only accept hard copy entries for the School Categories. Please take a picture of your illustration, fill up the online submission form and hand your hard copy to your school. We will send for a courier to pick up the hard copy submissions.

12. I accidentally uploaded the wrong file. Can I delete my entry and submit the correct file again?

- You will not be able to delete your entry. Resubmit your entry, after which drop us an email to indicate which is erroneous entry and we will follow-up from there.

13. When I submit an illustration/photograph for this competition, what rights does the organisers have to my submission?

- Intellectual property of the design submitted in the submission, and the submission itself, shall remain the ownership of the Participant.
- However, by entering the Competition, the Participants grant the Organisers an unrestricted, royalty-free, world-wide, perpetual, irrevocable, non-exclusive licence to use, apply, reproduce, display (such as at a public exhibition), broadcast, modify, summarise, adapt and communicate the design submitted in the submission, and the submission itself for any purpose whatsoever and at any time, including (but not limited to) communicating the design or submission to the public or to any entity or for any other communication campaigns the Organisers deem appropriate, which may include media, case studies, social media, feature articles and other forms, without any payment or compensation to the Participants.



- It is the Participants' responsibility to read the Competition's official **Terms and Conditions** for further information on the rights when submitting an entry to the PDD Hoarding Design Competition.

14. How will my entry be judged?

- The judging panel will select three (3) winners from each of the Categories (i.e. Open, Primary Schools and Secondary Schools), based on the following criteria:
 - a) Originality and Creativity of Image (40%)
 - b) Interpretation and Clarity in relation to the Theme (40%)
 - c) Quality of Artistic Composition (20%)

15. When and how will the winners be notified?

- Winners of each category will be announced in mid July after the closing date for submissions and will be notified by email/phone or through the school.

16. Where and when will the winning entries be displayed?

- The winning entries and selected entries for each theme will be exhibited at SIT and JTC events and will be displayed on the construction hoarding along Punggol Promenade Nature Walk. More details will be shared closer to the date.
